

Monthly Meeting
Hobart Township
January 11, 2022

Present: Terry Hockett, DuWayne Sonnenberg, Ryan Bruhn, Kathy Glawe, Debi Eischens and Tim Barry.

Chairman Hockett called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. The agenda was considered with no changes made.

Bruhn made a motion to approve the Minutes from the December 2021 meeting. Sonnenberg second. All in favor. Motion carried.

Glawe presented the Treasurer's report. Glawe stated that there needs to be a 26 cent adjustment to the totals. The report did not balance with the bank statement and the discrepancy was found after the report was printed. A corrected copy will be distributed. Bruhn made a motion to approve the Treasurer's report. Sonnenberg second. All in favor. Motion carried.

Bruhn made a motion to approve the disbursements as presented. Sonnenberg second. All in favor. Motion carried.

Barry presented a draft of the 2nd Amendment Bill to the Board for discussion. This basically is a stance that the Township will be a second amendment dedicated township. After further discussion, Bruhn made a motion to pass the resolution because of the number of residents of the Township that are gun owners and believe in the second amendment. Sonnenberg second. All in favor. Motion carried.

City of Vergas has requested input on how to get more users of the compost site to obtain the yearly permits. The Board suggested that the Clerk contact the County and ask if something could be added to the flyer that goes out to the taxpayers.

The East Otter Tail Spring Meeting will be held at Thumper Pond on March 7, 2022 at 1:30 p.m. The Perham EMS Meeting will be held January 25, 2022 at 6:00 pm at Cactus. Board of Equalization Meeting is set for April 20, 2022 at 9:30 a.m.

The insurance audit came back showing that the Township has limited coverage and suggested replacement cost. This would require a resolution. The audit also suggested increasing the deductible. This would also require a resolution. Bruhn made a motion to change the coverage to replacement coverage and increase the deductible to \$2500 based on the fact that it makes sense and is in the best interest of the Township. Sonnenberg second. All in favor. Motion carried.

A resolution was passed making the Town Hall the official polling place. This had been done earlier, but the Auditor's Office claims that they never received a copy of the resolution.

Discussion was held regarding retiring the old check blanks and ordering new ones that could be printed from CTAS. This not only makes it easier for the Treasurer, but makes better and clearer bookkeeping. Sonnenberg made a motion to approve ordering the new style of checks. Bruhn second. All in favor. Motion carried.

Since there was no further business to come before the Board, Hockett adjourned the meeting.
