Hobart Township Monthly Meeting May 13, 2025

Present: Larry Hoffmann, Scott Ehlke, Tim Hockett, Kathy Glawe, Russ Berstler, Tim Martin, Dan Howell, Tyler Treiglaff, and Torey Sonnenberg

Chairman Hoffmann called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Ehlke made a motion to approve the Minutes from the April 2025 meeting. Hockett second. All in favor. Motion Carried.

Ehlke made a motion to approve the Treasurer's report as presented. Hockett second. All in favor. Motion Carried.

Ehlke made a motion to approve the disbursements as presented. Hockett second. All in favor. Motion Carried.

Tim Martin asked what the process was to black top the remaining section of Good Oak Loop and Good Loop Trail. The board explained the process stating that the property owners/ residents would need to agree on the project. Tim was given contact information for the township engineer.

Dan Howell explained the drainage issue at 50411 East Lake 7 Rd. There is a culvert that needs to be cleaned out. Supervisor Ehlke will meet with Dan and Torey at the site to determine what action needs to be done.

Tyler Treiglaff from Burlington Township asked the Hobart board if they were interested in a joint gravel project on 520th St (shared road between Burlington and Hobart Townships). The board agreed with adding gravel and possibly dust guard to the 3/4 mile of road. Costs will be shared between the two townships.

The board went through the notes from the 2025 Road Tour that took place on April 19th. After discussion it was determined that the following work will be done in 2025.

- Add gravel to 520th St (Burlington/Hobart town line). (3/4 miles)
- Pull in the shoulders and add gravel to 460th St. (1 mile)
- Add gravel to a section of Black Dimond Rd and 505th St. (1 1/2 mile total)
- Add gravel to East Wymer Lake Rd. (2 miles)
- Brushing will be looked at in the fall / early winter
- Supervisor Ehlke will look into having the weeds sprayed on W Wymer Lake Rd that are growing on the rocks where the road goes between Graham and Wymer lakes.

Since there was no further business to come before the Board, Chairman Hoffmann adjourned the meeting.
