

Hobart Township Monthly Meeting
July 11, 2023

Present: Terry Hockett, DuWayne Sonnenberg, Larry Hoffmann, Kathy Glawe, Russ Berstler, Jennifer Carlson, and Cody Nunn

Chairman Hockett called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Sonnenberg made a motion to approve the Minutes from the June 2023 meeting. Hoffmann second. All in favor. Motion Carried.

The request to vacate the easement in front of the Carlson's' lot located at 51732 Lake Six Road was discussed. The board is concerned with keeping the best interest of the township in mind. The matter was tabled and no decision was made at this time.

An e-mail was received from Luke Ellenbaum concerning a blocked culvert at 50411 E Lake 7 Rd. Supervisor Hoffmann will look at the culvert.

An e-mail was received from Otter Tail Highway Department with the schedule for seal coat project on Lake Six Rd. Work is scheduled to start this week.

An e-mail was received stating the STOP sign for Northbound traffic at the intersection of Good Oak Look & E Wymer Lake RD is again missing. Cody stated that Sonnenberg Excavating will replace the sign.

Cody asked the board for the list of action items for Sonnenberg Excavating from the 2023 road tour. Clerk Berstler printed out the list for Cody.

MN DOT asked to use the Hobart Town Hall on August 16th for an informational meeting on the construction project at the intersection of HWY 10 and Count Road 60 that is scheduled to take place in 2024. The board granted permission as it was deemed beneficial to the residents of Hobart Township.

Chairman Hockett and supervisor Sonnenberg gave an update on the EMS meeting held on June 26, 2023.

Supervisor Hoffmann asked what the next steps were for resurfacing the blacktop on 460th St. Supervisor Sonnenberg will contact Jeff Stabnow to determine what work would be needed on the road and get an estimate of the cost. This would be a joint project with Edna Township and cost would need to be presented at the 2024 annual meeting for approval by the electors.
