## Hobart Township Monthly Meeting December 20, 2022

An email was read asking about snow plowing on a section of Wymer Lake Loop. After discussion it was decided that the township road survey will be reviewed to determine if that section of road is under township road maintenance.

Supervisor Sonnenberg stated that during the November 29 tar road evaluation that he and supervisor Hockett discussed the speed bumps on 405<sup>TH</sup> ST with the Antonsen's. It was explained that the speed bumps were not allowed on that section of road. If the speed bumps were placed there that the Antonsen's could be held liable for any damages caused by the speed bumps.

Supervisor Hoffmann attended the Vergas Fire Department meeting on November 29. Hoffman reported that there would be a 10% increase in operating cost for fire support from 2022 to 2023. Hobart township is responsible for 44.3% of the cost. The annual Vergas Fire Department meeting is set for February 6<sup>th</sup>, 2023.

Since there was no further business to come before the Board, Hockett adjourned the meeting.
