Josh Hanson raised concerns with lack of stop signs where 504th St, 365th Ave, and W Wymer Lake Rd intersect. This matter had been discussed at the September meeting and had been decided to place a stop or yield sign on the gravel roads at the intersection and make the blacktop road a through road without stop or yield signs. Torey will place the signs.

Josh Hanson also raised a safety concern with how narrow W Wymer Lake Rd gets where it passes between Grahm and Wymer lakes and asked if guard rails could be put in place. Torey raised concerns with guard rails interfering with snow removal. The Board will look into the matter.

As of the meeting there has been no response from Eric & Amy Zitzow to the board's request for an approach permit for the approach at 51115 W Wymer Lake RD. It was decided that a certified letter be sent to Eric & Amy Zitzow along with a permit application and an invited to attend the February board meeting.
