Hobart Township Monthly Meeting July 8, 2025

Chairman Hoffmann called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

The supervisors stated that one of the residents on the road had attended the May meeting and was contacting the other property owners/ residents to see if they had interest in the project.

Dan Howell asked about the progress with the culvert clean out on East Lake 7 Rd. Supervisor Hoffmann stated that he would contact Sonnenberg Excavating, supervisor Ehlke stated that he would contact Dan and give him an update.

An email from Otter Tail County about their newly adopted cannabis ordnance. The board stated that they would most likely pass a resolution to delegate authority to Otter Tail County for the purposes of registration and compliance. The board will review the county ordinance and discuss at the August meeting. Clerk Berstler was asked to register the township with the state Office of Cannabis Management (OCM) so the township would be notified of applications.

Chairman Hoffmann stated that CDH Vergas Rescue was supporting Dent Rescue. Hoffmann will get with CDH Vergas Recue to find out how this support was being handled.

Since there was no further business to come before the Board, Chairman Hoffmann adjourned the meeting.
